This pamphlet is written to help us reflect on the relationship between faith and financial stewardship within our congregation.

Financial stewardship is an act of worship that allows us to participate in God's vision.

Financial stewardship:

- Helps us realise the abundance in our lives.
- Creates a discipline that spiritually sustains and nourishes us.
- Allows us to invest in projects of mercy that plant seeds to become a blessing for the future.
- Provides us the chance to trust that God is doing something bigger, greater and far more reaching than we know.

We love because God first loved us. We give because God first gave to us. We are blessed because God reached down and blessed us with mercy, peace, and grace in Jesus.

Spiritual GIVING

So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. 2 Corinthians 9:7

The good things that God does in and through the church happen through your generosity in serving, caring and financial stewardship. There are many ways you can provide tax-deductible financial support to Briarwood.

Envelopes: These enable the giver to direct how the offering is to be used: General Funds, Presbyterian Sharing, Other (such as PWS&D).

Pre Authorized Remittance (PAR):

Using the PAR program allows you to use your existing banking services to give intentionally, proportionally and faithfully to the church. It provides our church with a dependable flow of contributions.

Special Offerings: These are in response to social crises in the world, such as the 2010 earthquake in Haiti. We also have a special offering at Christmas that supports a local mission.

Planned Giving: Planned giving is a long-term financial contribution that may include assets other than cash

such as property, stock and annuities.

How Much Do I Give? There really is no simple answer to this question and it is a deeply personal decision. Paul in 1st Corinthians 16:2 advises us to give as God hath prospered us. Maybe you can give 10% of your net income, maybe 5%; God knows your heart. Members are encouraged to pray on what they feel God is calling them to commit to the church.
